

Terms & Conditions for the participating Institutions/Colleges/Universities

- 1) The permission shall be given to the Institutions/Colleges/Universities for organizing Career counselling/fair is specifically based on the documents submitted by the applicant against each Institution/College/University.
- 2) The permission shall be given to the Institutions/Colleges/ Universities for the academic session 2017-18 only.
- 3) The courses/branches of the Institutions/ Colleges should be affiliated to University/Board/ Council or other Statutory Body.
- 4) For Institutions/Colleges/Universities offering Medical Education including Dental Education, the allotment of seat is strictly based on National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET). So, the Institutions/Colleges/Universities are not allowed to take part in student's counselling process individually or in edu-fair.
- 5) Institutions/Colleges/Universities offering Pharmacy courses must be approved by the Pharmacy Council of India respectively for this specific year of admission.
- 6) Institutions/Colleges/ Universities offering Architecture courses must be approved by the Council of Architecture and AICTE for this specific year of admission.
- 7) Institutions/Colleges offering Engineering Courses (Diploma/Under Graduate/Post Graduate), Management courses, MCA must be approved by the AICTE for this specific year of admission.
- 8) Institutions/Colleges offering Courses related to Nursing Science must be approved by the Nursing Council of India, State Nursing Council. Institutions/Colleges offering Courses related to Nursing Science must have separate boy's and girl's hostels with decent space and hygiene within the campus and if not within the campus, the institution should have daily transport facility made available for the students. The Institutes must be attached to one or more Hospitals for practicing and internship.
- 9) University/College/Institute shall not charge any capitation fee/accept donation and disclose total fee structure to the students as per Fee Regulated by the State Government of respective State where the college is situated and shall not charge any fee after admission. The fee charged by the institution should be deposited directly to the institute's account instead of any agent or third party mediator.
- 10) Facilities published through booklets/ brochures /pamphlet/website should not be deviated from the actual/original terms for each institution located in a particular spot.
- 11) Student's original documents should not be mortgaged and semester certificates should not be retained for any unforeseen/vested reason.

- 12) Giving permission to organize career counselling or Edu-fair doesn't mean that Department of Higher Education is either empanelling any University/College/Institute or promoting them in any manner.
- 13) If any information/clause/point publicised by the University/College/Institution attracting students is found fraud/incorrect later on, then it will be liable to face legal action as per law.
