

Instruction to the Students and Parents

Considering protection of life and career of students of the State from the false commitment/assurance given before admission of students in various professional/technical courses by the institutions/colleges/Universities given directly or by the organizers/ Career Counselor while organizing Edu-Fair and career counseling in the State, Higher Education Department, Government of Tripura, being authorized as designated authority for regulating Edu Fair/Career Counseling shall permit Institution/Colleges/Universities for organizing Edu Fair/Career Counseling based on the documents submitted by the applicant against each Institutions/Colleges/Universities.

Giving permission to organize career counseling or Edu-fair doesn't mean that Department of Higher Education is either empanelling such Universities/Colleges/Institutions or promoting them in any manner.

Further, Students intended to take admission in various private Technical/ Professional courses outside the State should verify the following before take admission:

1. That all the Courses/Branches of the Institute/College/University have the approval of Indian Nursing Council/Pharmacy Council of India/AICTE/Bar Council of India/ Council of Architecture/State Nursing Council and from the concerned University, whichever is applicable.
2. That the Institute/College/University has its own academic building with the provision of good laboratories, libraries and spacious classrooms as per norms of the respective Councils/Body/Statutory bodies.
3. That the Institute/College/University has adequate number of qualified faculties with good teaching background.
4. That the Institute/College/University has indicated fee structure for each course in the year of admission or the total course fees fixed by the Regulatory Authority of the concerned State Government.
5. That the Institute/College/University has disclosed in detail the nature and location of hostel having adequate provisions of running water, safe drinking water, electricity, furniture, food supply (quantity and type), distance from hostel to college on charging extra fees for fooding and lodging from the student at the time of admission.
6. That Health care facility shall be made available to the students by the Institute/College/University. The Institute/College/University has ensured hospital attachment or proof of tie-up with nearby hospitals for medical treatment of the students and also ensured guarantee of issuing health card to each students for providing treatment facilities, in case of serious illness.

7. That the Institute/College/University has good placement record in the preceding year.
8. Institutions/Colleges offering Courses related to Nursing Science must be approved by the Nursing Council of India, State Nursing Council. Institutions/Colleges offering Courses related to Nursing Science must have separate boy's and girl's hostel with decent space and hygiene. The Institute must be attached to one or more Hospitals for practicing and internship.
9. Student's original documents should not be mortgaged and semester certificates should not be retained for any unforeseen/vested reason.
10. That the Institute/College/University ensured no extra demand for donation/capitation fees.
